

Peter FANCSOVITS (2010)

Peter Fancsovits obtained his M.Sc. degree from Gödöllő University of Agricultural Sciences in the field of reproductive biology in 1993. He becomes acquainted with IVF and embryology on a fellowship at the University of Wisconsin, (Madison, USA) than started to work at the IVF unit of the Agricultural Biotechnology Center, Gödöllő.

Since 1998 he is the head of the Embryology Laboratory at the Division of Assisted Reproduction, Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology, Semmelweis University School of Medicine, Budapest.

He obtained his Ph.D. in 2006 on Semmelweis University School of Medicine.

In 2008 he obtained his certification as Senior Clinical Embryologist.

His special research interests are the oocyte and embryo morphology and the effect of morphological parameters on IVF outcome.

He published 25 articles in international and Hungarian journals and delivered more than 70 lectures on different conferences and workshops.

He is member of ESHRE (European Society of Human Reproduction and Embryology) since 2001 and member of ALPHA Scientists in Reproductive Medicine since 2003.

He became member of the Executive Committee of ALPHA and had been elected to the Committee of National Representatives of ESHRE in 2008.

He was the congress president of the 8th Biennial Conference of ALPHA in 2010 which was held in Budapest, Hungary with more than 300 participants.
